I've gotten every one of Hannah Lynn's books, and I love them, but this artist (Scot Howden) actually equals hers, plus he draws a nose, which makes him a step up in my opinion! The artistry is less child-like, too. The quality of the paper is about the same as every other adult coloring book on - fine for colored pencils with no bleed through, but I bought a coloring book (think owls, nature, tiny sections) specifically because it came with a plastic sheet to place behind the page that I'm working on, which saves tons of paper over time, instead of using several blank sheets to prevent bleed-through or pencil marks on the page behind. Then, if I do use markers, I can just clean the plastic protector with rubbing alcohol, and I'm good to go again! There

are two sets of each drawing in this book (one whole set follows the original set - not 2 next to each other), which is great if you want to try different techniques. I also like the fact that the drawings go from simple and quick, to quite intricate. I highly recommend this book!

Colouring Fantasy is a coloring book for adults and teens featuring 24 single sided fantasy art illustrations created from some of my favourite paintings including mermaids, fairies, wildlife, dragons and exotic maidens. There are also 2 bonus pages containing enlarged drawing sections that can be used as practice for some of the more complex details. The illustrations are single sided (blank page on the back). This helps to ensure that your colouring medium doesn't bleed through to the next picture. I recommend using coloured pencils and suggest placing several sheets of paper or a sheet of card behind the page that you are working on.
