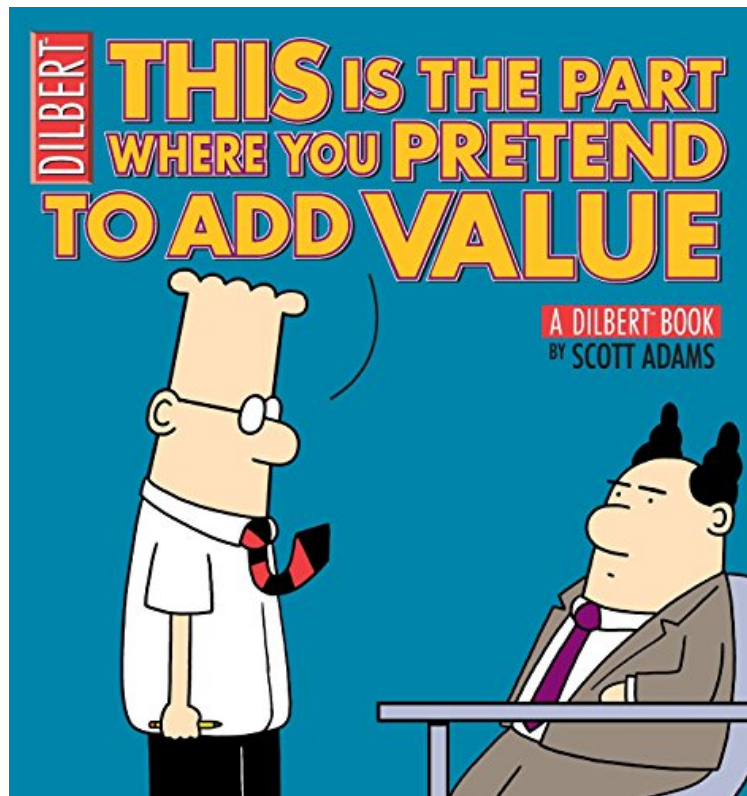


This Is the Part Where You Pretend to Add Value: A Dilbert Book
